Model of Care - Principles

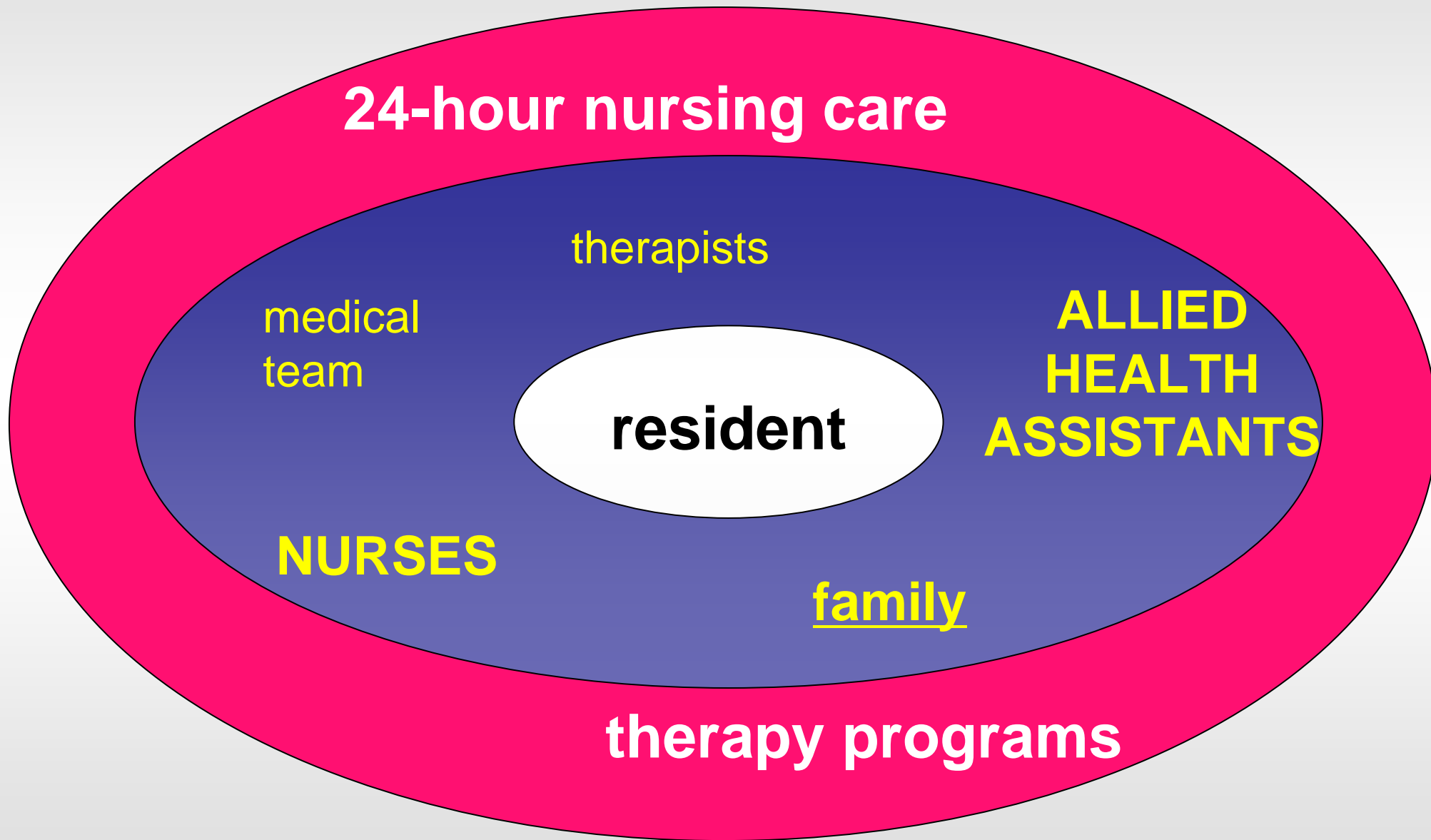
Potential for Improvement

- Time limited residency.
